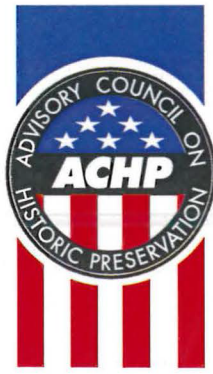


Dear Mr. Reynolds:

In response to a notification by the City of Chicago, Illinois (City), the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) will participate in consultation to consider the effect of the referenced undertaking on historic properties. Our decision to participate in this consultation is based on the *Criteria for Council Involvement in Reviewing Individual Section 106 Cases*, contained within our regulations. The criteria are met for this proposed undertaking because the consultation has the potential for presenting procedural problems.

Section 800.6(a)(1)(iii) of our regulations requires that we notify you, as the head of the agency, of our decision to participate in consultation.
